Christer Carlsson's memorial fund seeks to help students, student groups or people closely related to students in need of support dealing with loss. In order for the application to be approved the purpose must be able to be linked to a student or student group at Linköping University.

Application is made by filling out the <u>following form</u>. The form is handled by all Student Unions and therefore you do not have to worry about Student Union affiliation

Purpose	Description	Amount of funding
Support for relatives	For example, contributions to costs in the event of the student's death. Such as hiring a moving company and moving cleaning, any travel expenses or remaining rent.	Up to 10 000 SEK
Memorials	For example, coffee or anything else that may be needed during ceremony. Both at arranged memorials and other ways of mourning together.	Up to 2 000 SEK
Support for dealing with loss for the student's partner or surviving children	For example, activity for the remaining family with the aim of handling their grief	Up to 5 000 SEK
Support for student groups affected by a loss.	For example, a dinner to talk to each other and remember your friend in a more personal context than a memorial service or other joint activity for dealing with grief	Up to 5 000 SEK
Crisis management for student groups	For example, an activity that does not necessarily need to be linked to a passing	Up to 5 000 SEK

Processing

The application will be processed by all Student Unions within 5 working days. Processing time may be delayed during holiday periods. Upon approved application, payment will be made by Kårservice AB within 5 working days of the approved application.

If the funding is approved, the recipient of the payment shall send in a report (approximately 100-250 words) about how the funding has been used within 2 months after the use of the funding. Template for the report will be sent out in conjunction with the approved funding.
